

Covid-19 - Policy

Tree of Life Ministries Church will be limiting capacities as the State of WI, Washington County or local authorities give recommendations for capacity limits.

For all staff essential to business operations and visitors, we require you to follow these precautions and steps while in our facilities:

If you are experiencing symptoms such as cough, fever or fatigue; or have been in contact with someone who is sick or has tested positive with Covid-19 within the last 14 days, love your neighbor and please do not enter the building or have contact with anyone here. Put others' health and safety first.

If you are healthy, you may enter the building however you will be asked to strictly follow this procedure.

1. Wash or sanitize your hands after entering the building.
2. Chairs in the sanctuary will be spaced to help with social distancing. Those of separate households should use best efforts to maintain social distancing. Handshakes and hugs will not be allowed.
3. Coffee and juice will be available and will be served to you upon request. Cups will be a onetime use only. Morning fellowship before and after service is closed until further notice. The bubbler/water fountain will also be closed.
4. Facility will be sanitized after every service according to CDC guidelines including all touch surfaces and countertops. Hand sanitizer will be available in readily accessible areas.
5. Communion will be offered in a safe manner with minimal contact.
6. Offering is to be placed in the basket on the back counter to limit interaction.
7. Sunday school will be held as usual with extra sanitation between shared items.
8. Nursery will be available but will be limited. Parents and guardians are encouraged to help keep everything sanitized.
9. Attendees are encouraged to bring their own Bibles, however Bibles will still be available for use and will be quarantined for 72 hours following service.
10. Wash your hands when you arrive at home.

Higher Risk Individuals (Age 65 and older, those who have serious underlying medical conditions or are immunocompromised and those who care for High Risk Individuals) are also encouraged to attend our online services.

Recorded services will still be available online shortly after the conclusion of the services for those who wish not to attend in person.
